#### **RESEARCH ABSTRACT**

## **Research Topic:**

The study of dialectics (citations and responses to them in the Exegesis of At-Tabari). What do they mean? What are their types? Analysis of questions on surah al-Fatiha and beginning of surah al-Baqarah.

# **Research Objective:**

- 1- Investigating dialectics of at-Tabari in his exegesis and compiling them comprehensively so that it will be an exegesis provision which negates criticisms on them and highlight his opinion and reasoning in the clearest form, evidence and proofs, defense of citation, grammatical benefits and linguistic perspectives.
- 2- Study of these citations and their responses with comparison and analysis.
- 3- Deriving evidences and proofs of meanings in these questions and answers, and meticulous meanings of verses in a style that will elicit hidden concern in addition to comparison and analysis of its contents using other books of exegesis.

### **Research Problem:**

Depth of the issues raised by at-Tabari (may Allah have mercy on him) in dialectical exegesis when joined to other important and meticulous matters necessitates their study and analysis, and highlighting elements of exegesis by opinion according to Ibn Jarir of which these dialectics contain a great deal of them.



# **Research findings:**

- 1- Dialectics and responses to questions in Jami' al-Bayan are manifestations of the high ranking of at-Tabari in exegesis. He does not only states chains of narration but also investigates views and distinguishes them with proofs and circumstantial evidences, manifesting great capability in debate and supporting his preferred meanings with strong arguments and also refuting criticism on them or clarifying ambiguities surrounding them.
- 2- Leadership of at-Tabari in the area of exegesis by opinion and reasoning is not less than his leadership in the area of exegesis by narrations and this is indicated by these dialectics and responses to citations.
- 3- These dialectics and citations contains linguistics matters and eloquence which the exegesis of at-Tabari comprises. In surah al-Fatiha alone there are (3) dialectics hence, whoever wants to know the explanations and their various fields in tafsir al-Jami', the fruits are hidden in these questions and responses of at-Tabari.

#### **Research Abstract**

#### **Research Topic:**

Compilation of ahadith used by those who contradict Ahlu Sunnah wal Jama' which indicate beginning of legislation of call to prayer before the Prophetic migration, studying them critically and judging them.

#### **Research Objective:**

- 2- Explaining the invalidity of the view of the people of innovation on the issue of beginning of legislation of call to prayer before the Prophetic migration and their contradiction of Ahlu Sunnah wal Jama'.
- 3- Explaining the innocence of Ahlu Sunnah wal Jama' concerning what they have been accused of.

#### **Research Problem:**

The author of the book (the call to prayer-between authenticity and distortion) claimed the Ahlu Sunnah wal Jama' contradicted what is established in the books of Sunnah concerning the issue of the beginning of the call to prayer, arguing that it was legislated before the Prophetic migration.

# HADITH OF SALAMATA BIN SAKHR AL-BAYAADHI (MAY ALLAH BE PLEASED WITH HIM) AND ITS RELATION WITH THE HADITH OF THE MAN WHO HAD INTERCOURSE DURING RAMADAN A HADITH STUDY

#### **Research Abstract**

#### **Research Topic:**

I read the statement of some scholars about the hadith of the Bedouin who had intercourse during the daytime of Ramadan, so they said he was Salamata bin Sahkr, may Allah be pleased with him. I also saw similarity between the wordings of the hadith of the person who had intercourse during the daytime of Ramadan and the hadith of Salamata who did zihaar to his wife. I also read the view of some scholars that the hadith of Salamata is weak while others grade it as authentic. So, I decided to compile the chains of the narration and study them with their narrators.

#### **Importance of the Research Topic:**

The hadith of Salamata comprises many jurisprudential rulings and hadith related benefits. Muslim jurist have derived a lot of benefits from it and it is considered a reference concerning the issue of having intercourse before the expiation of zihaar. Many have confused this hadith with the hadith of the person who had intercourse during the daytime of Ramadan just as scholars have disputed over its authenticity.

#### **Research Problem:**

What is the authenticity of the hadith of Salamata bin Sakhr?

What are the chains of narration?

Is it the same with the hadith of the Bedouin who had intercourse during the daytime of Ramadan or not?



What are the difference between them?

Who are the scholars that consider them as same and what are their evidences?

#### **Research Methodology:**

I followed the methodology of investigation, analysis and derivation by investigating and compiling the chains of narration of the hadith, analyzing them and deriving appropriate rulings on them.

#### **Research Finding:**

- The hadith of Salamata bin Sakhr does not have an authentic chain of narration and all its narrations are defective. However, by the combined effects of all its chains of narration it can be used as evidence and scholars have indeed used it as evidence.
- None of those who narrated from him can be confirmed to have heard from him, and the authentic hadith of Abu Huraira concerning the person who had intercourse during the daytime of Ramadan is completely different from the hadith of Salamata bin Sakhr.
- A lot of scholars and commentators on hadith mixed up the two hadith hence they regarded the anonymous as Salamata bin Sakhr.
