### A Descriptive Study

### Research Abstract

#### Research Topic:

A descriptive study on the project for the Audio Collection of the Authentic Successive Modes of Reading (al- Qirā'āt al-Mutawātir) at the College of the Holy Qur'an.

#### Research Objectives:

Highlighting the critical role played by the Islamic University, and the College of the Holy Qur'an in particular, in effectively and creatively disseminating the Qirā'āt (modes of Qur'anic reading) discipline, which helps familiarize and introduce the discipline to learners practically.

#### Research Problem:

Which Qirā'āt are recorded within the Audio Collection Program of the Holy Qur'an? Who are the reciters participating in the Program, and what is their approach to reciting? Is the Program completed? What does it need to be completed?

#### Research Findings:

The Program includes recordings of the seven Qirā'āt according to the al-Shāṭibiyah route, starting from Sūrat al-Fāṭiḥah till verse 18 of Sūrat al-Ḥijr. The total count of the recorded tapes is 277, divided into 830 episodes.

#### Keywords:

Collecting – Audio – College of the Holy Qur'an – Qirā'āt.

The research findings indicate that Sūrat al-A'īlā focuses on highlighting the exaltedness of Allah above His creation that He proportioned, His immense Power, and His guidance. The Sūrah also demonstrates Allah's Ability to facilitate the mission of delivering the message, revealing Divine guidance, and establishing the Shari'ah. Additionally, the Sūrah explores the various types



of people who encounter this Divine call and message, as well as the reasons that discourage them from accepting it. Furthermore, the Sūrah declares that the Messengers did not invent this message.
