Research Topic:

The Impact of Phonetic Assimilation on the Interpretation of the Glorious Qur'an in Verses from Juz' 'Amma.

Research Objective:

To determine the extent to which phonetic assimilation affects the interpretation of the Glorious Qur'an in Juz' 'Amma.

Research Significance:

1. The richness of short surahs in phonetic assimilation, which plays a prominent role in their meaning.
2. The lack of previous studies specifically focused on phonetic assimilation in short surahs.

Research Problem:

Short surahs are abundant in phonetic assimilation, necessitating a study of this phenomenon.

Research Methodology:

The descriptive-analytical approach is followed. The concept of phonetic assimilation is discussed linguistically and contextually, with explanations of partial assimilation substitution, full assimilation, assimilation and i'lāl (vowel alteration), and assimilation and imālah (vowel inclination).

Key Findings:

The researcher concluded that:

1. Phonetic assimilation involves the adaptive modifications of a sound due to its adjacency to other sounds.
2. One of the implications of phonetic assimilation in short surahs is exaggeration and emphasis.
3. There is a relationship between assimilation and ibdāl (substitution), as the subsequent sound affects the preceding sound.
4. I'lāl (vowel alteration) aims to achieve sound harmony through assimilation.
5. Imālah (vowel inclination) aims to create a type of assimilation and seek lightness in pronunciation.

Key Recommendations:

To conduct a study on assimilation in Surah al-Ra'd.

To conduct a study on assimilation in Juz' Tabāraka.

Research Abstract

Research Topic:

This research delves into the study and investigation of a manuscript from the 12th century, namely, the interpretation of Surah al-Fath from the book: *al-Ajwibah al-Jaliyyah 'an al-As'ilah al-Khafiyyah fī Tafsīr al-Āyāt al-Qur'āniyyah* (Clear Answers to the Subtle Questions in the Interpretation of the Qur'anic Verses) by 'Alī bin Muhammad 'Alā' al-Dīn al-Miṣrī (d. 1127 AH).

Research Objectives:

1. To edit and investigate a portion of the manuscript, including a study of the author.

1. Its mention in some hadiths and its inclusion by some interpreters in their *tafsīrs* (interpretations) with the title “Verse of Majesty.”
2. This honorable verse establishes praise for Allah, affirms His Exclusivity, negates His taking a son or partner in His dominion, or protector out of weakness, and commands His glorification and exaltation. It also indicates that whoever possesses these qualities is the invincible, conquering Mighty.

Takbīr is the most eloquent Arabic word for glorification and exaltation, signifying the glorification of Allah, the Almighty. Allah’s negation of having a son or partner is because He, the Almighty, is the owner, and all others are owned. He is the one who has control, and all others are controlled. He is the Rich in His essence from all aspects, and the created beings are in dire need of Him from all aspects. Allah, the Almighty, is the Only One who deserves praise in its entirety.

A Compilation and Study

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Research Abstract

Research Topic:

The Implications of Expressions Indicating Fear of Error in Ibn Khuzaimah's
Ṣaḥīḥ: A Compilation and Study.

Research Objectives:

This research aims to elucidate the implications of expressions indicating fear of error employed by Imam Ibn Khuzaimah in his Ṣaḥīḥ. The objectives are to compile the hadiths in which Ibn Khuzaimah expressed such fear, authenticate their chains of narration, analyze their isnāds, and pass judgment upon them according to the established principles of hadith scholars. Additionally, the study will examine the comments of hadith critics on these hadiths.

Research Problem:

The research addresses the lack of a dedicated study that explicates the implications of expressions indicating fear of error used by Imam Ibn Khuzaimah. It also analyzes the hadiths to which these expressions refer, especially considering that the hadiths included in Ibn Khuzaimah's Ṣaḥīḥ are generally deemed authentic by him.

Research Findings:

The total number of hadiths included in this study is five. All of these hadiths, in which Ibn Khuzaimah employed expressions of fear of error, are considered weak due to discrepancies in their chains of narration.

Restricted Invalidation and its Impact on the Narrator's Narrations: An Application to Some Samples of Imam 'Abd al-Razzāq al-San'ānī's Narrations—

Research Abstract

Research Topic:

This research tackles the extent of the impact of restricted invalidation on the narrations of trustworthy narrators ,by weakening their narrations while being invalidated in a restricted manner ,by applying this to some samples of the narrator 'Abd al-Razzāq al-San'ānī's narrations.

Research Problem:

The different conditions of the trustworthy narrator and the impact of this difference on authenticating or weakening his narrations.

Research Objective:

Stating some forms of the restricted invalidation of narrators, and identifying the use of it by the critic imams, and its impact on weakening the narrator's narrations which he narrates while being weak.

Key Findings:

1. The critic imams were extremely concerned with studying the conditions of the narrators and their narrations, even if they were trustworthy.
2. Considering narrator's different conditions when judging the authenticity of his

Hadiths, and not completely surrendering to absolute documentation without knowing the restricted invalidation on the narrator's narrations.

3. Weakness of the narrations of Imam 'Abd al-Razzāq: at the end of his life after he became blind, when purely narrating from memory, his narrations from Sufyān in Makkah, and some of his narrations from 'Ubayd Allah bin 'Umar.
