Following the Angels: The Qur'anic Call to Perform Abstention Acts of Worship

ABSTRACT

Introduction:

This study explores the Qur'anic directives that call upon believers to adopt abstention acts of worship attributed to the angels.

Rationale:

- The subject matter of this research pertains to the second pillar of Islam, a crucial component of a sound and authentic faith.
- It is among the key topics that pertains to the faith in the unseen, a central tenet of Islam that God has made obligatory and commended in the Qur'an as a characteristic of the pious and guided.
- This research demonstrates the fallacy of the claim that angels are passive beings akin to celestial bodies, devoid of agency and compelled to perform worship. A careful examination of Qur'anic verses related to angelic worship reveals their active role and voluntary nature.
- The effect of embracing angelic attributes on believers' worship and their adherence to God's commands, following the model set by the angels (Peace be upon them).

Objectives:

- To compile the Qur'anic verses pertaining to the abstention acts of worship performed by, and to analyze and categorize them based on thematic content.
- To establish a connection between abstention acts of worship performed by angels, as mentioned in the Qur'an, and similar commands directed to believers.
- To elucidate the methods employed by the Qur'an in instructing believers to follow what God has characterized as abstention acts of worship performed by the angels.



Research Question

- The study aims to address the following questions:
- What are the Qur'anic verses that describe the abstention practices of angels?
- What is the underlying wisdom behind the Qur'an's mentions of certain angelic attributes?
- Are these abstention practices exclusive to angels or also commended for believers?
- How does the Qur'an encourage believers to adopt the abstention practices attributed to angels?
- Methodology
- A descriptive, inductive and thematic methodology was adopted for this research.

Conclusion

- The authenticity of the abstention acts of worship performed by angels, six of which are mentioned in the Qur'an, all signifying complete devotion, submission, obedience, and reverence toward Allah, the Almighty.
- The Qur'anic portrayal of angelic abstention acts of worship confirms the fact they are accountable for religious duties and obligations.
- The legitimacy of emulating angelic acts of worship is established by the Qur'anic command for believers to follow their example within human capacity. God has informed us about angelic worship practices and encouraged believers to adopt similar approaches.
- This study demonstrates that all abstention acts of worship attributed to angels are also mandated for believers, despite the fact that angels are inherently created to obey and worship, executing these acts with complete diligence, free from sloth, fatigue, or boredom. In contrast, believers are instructed to struggle against their baser desires, exercise patience, persevere in their worship, and guard themselves against succumbing to whims and temptations.
- The Qur'an utilizes a range of rhetorical devices to motivate believers

to adopt the abstention practices exemplified by angels. These include explicit commands, prohibitions, and implicit directives inferred from various contextual clues.

- The various directives given to believers regarding the abstention acts of worship, as exemplified by the angels, reveal several shared principles:
- Allah accepts worship only from those who submit wholeheartedly, rejecting pride and disdain. Those who exhibit arrogance or haughtiness are promised humiliation and disgrace in both this world and the Hereafter.
- All those accountable with the duty of worship are commanded to persevere in their devotion, overcoming challenges and maintaining consistency. This applies to all individuals, regardless of their nature and abilities, as obedience and worship are inherently fulfilling and pleasing to the soul. Allah, in His mercy and kindness, has commanded His servants only with what is beneficial for them.
- Allah's commands and prohibitions are absolute. No one can disobey or neglect them. Worship is valid only when performed according to Allah's prescribed methods.
- No one can claim superiority over God or His Messenger, either in words or actions.
- All beings, angelic and human, are bound by the limits of their knowledge and must refrain from speaking or acting on matters beyond their understanding.
- Allah has made it obligatory for all His creatures to worship Him alone, rejecting polytheism and its adherents.

Ambiguity of Hadiths on Sitting in the Two Tashahhuds

ABSTRACT

Introduction:

The focus of this research is on the hadiths that detail the Prophet Muhammad's ,May the blessings of Allah be upon him, posture during the first and second Tashahhud in prayer.

Research Question

There are multiple descriptions for the prayers of the Prophet Muhammad, May the blessings of Allah be upon him, each with its unique characteristics. Some descriptions are general, while others are more specific to the first or second Tashahhud. Due to the varying number of prayer units, scholars have disagreed on which descriptions most accurately reflect Sunnah.

Objectives:

To compile the hadiths pertaining to this topic, conduct a thorough study and evaluation of them, and address any apparent ambiguity through a critical analysis, while highlighting the key rules derived from the collection of hadiths.

Methodology:

This research adopted a critical-inductive methodology.

Conclusion

In this research, I have reached several key conclusions, the most important of which are:

- 1- Six authentic hadiths that pertains to the Prophet Muhammad's (peace be upon him) posture during the first and second Tashahhud in prayer were identified. The wording of the first and second hadiths were disputed, and I provided a detailed response for them.
- 2- The differences in Prophet Muhammad's (peace be upon him) sitting posture during the Tashahhud are primarily for the sake of priority. Therefore, any sitting position is valid for prayer.

- 3- The most preponderant opinion is to combine different sitting postures, as suggested by the general nature of the hadiths. The original position for both Tashahhud is al-iftirāsh (sitting on the left foot), as indicated by the hadiths of Wa'il and Aisha. However, for prayers with two Tashahhuds, al-tawarruk (sitting on the left thigh) is specifically recommended, as per the hadith of Abu Hamid al-Sa'idi.
- 4- The research provided a clear explanation of al-iftirāsh and al-tawarruk sitting postures as described in Sunnah.
- 5- The hadiths discussing women's sitting posture during prayer are weak, and therefore, women should follow the same sitting positions as men.
- 6- The research explored the underlying wisdom behind the differences in sitting posture between the first and second Tashahhud.
- 7- The research refuted the claims prohibiting al-tawarruk, establishing its validity based on Sunnah evidence.

This research investigates the scholarly discussion concerning the ruling on greeting worshippers after the prayer .By compiling relevant evidence and examining the opinions of Islamic scholars, this study seeks to establish a conclusion that is rooted in Sunnah and avoids innovation.

Objectives:

This study focuses on the practice of loud post-prayer greetings in Muslim mosques ,assessing its conformity to Sunnah ,the underlying evidence ,and the views of Islamic scholars.

Research Question

Determining the conformity of this phenomenon to Sunnah.

Methodology:

An inductive approach was used to analyze the evidence and scholarly opinions concerning post-prayer greetings .By examining the available information ,I aimed to reach the most preponderant opinion regarding Sunnah in this matter.

Conclusion

There is no definitive hadith evidence to support the claim that the Prophet Muhammad) peace be upon him) greeted his family with a peace salutation upon returning from leading the prayer.

The Sunnah of greeting worshippers with the intention of fostering community is fulfilled by simply uttering the finishing greetings of the prayer.

The assertion that greeting worshippers post-prayer is permissible, citing the hadith about greetings at the end of gatherings, is debatable. There is no authenticated narration of the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) or his companions (may Allah be pleased with them) engaging in this practice.
